



2027 Scenic Rally Tours Championship Regulations

1. Regulations

Competitors must compete in at least one of the individual events to be able to qualify for Scenic Rally Tour (SRT) Championship points – by doing so they confirm their acceptance of these 2027 SRT Championship regulations. All competitors on each event will automatically be enrolled to the Championship. Those wishing not to be entered should email info@scenicrallytours.com before the event they are taking part in.

Points are scored by the individual competitor (driver and navigator). The competitor is entitled to compete in different cars on different events and have different drivers/navigators on different events.

Points are awarded on an individual events basis.

Competitors can compete in one, two or three SRT Championship events. The top driver and top navigator at the end of the Championship will receive an award.

In the event of a tie, the win will go to the competitor with the highest class position on any event. If a tie still exists, the best overall positions will be taken into account, and finally the least penalties at the first timing point of the first Regularity completed by the competitor.

Young Timer and Modern Classes are not eligible for Championship points.

These SRT Championship regulations should be read in conjunction with each events Additional Supplementary Regulations and Scenic Rally Tours Standard Regulations.

2. Points

Points awarded to both driver and navigator individually are:

- First overall on a SRT Championship event will be awarded 15 Championship points.
- First in class are awarded 10 SRT Championship points.
- Second in class are awarded 5 SRT Championship points (where more than five cars in the class on the event).
- Third in class are awarded 3 SRT Championship points (where more than 10 cars in the class on the event).

Therefore, the maximum number of points per participant per event is 15. The first overall does not qualify for a first in class award or points.

3. Awards

The winning driver and the winning navigator will both receive an award and £100 discount on any 2028 event booked.

The second place driver and navigator will both receive £50 discount on any 2028 event booked.

It is anticipated the Championship award winners will be announced at the Prize Giving Dinner on the final event, subject to any appeals and disputes being raised with the Organisers.

4. Disputes

The Organisers reserve the right to adjudicate on any queries raised regarding the allocation of points. A provisional points table will be published on the Scenic Rally Tours website as soon as possible after each event. Participants will have seven days in which to raise any queries. These must be submitted in writing. If appropriate, a further set of points will be published which will remain open to query for a further seven days from publication. Once this period has expired the points will be considered final and not subject to any further amendment. This is with the exception of the final event of the Championship as the Championship results will

be made provisional after the event results are Final and there will be a 30-minute period for queries and appeals before the Championship results are declared FINAL.
